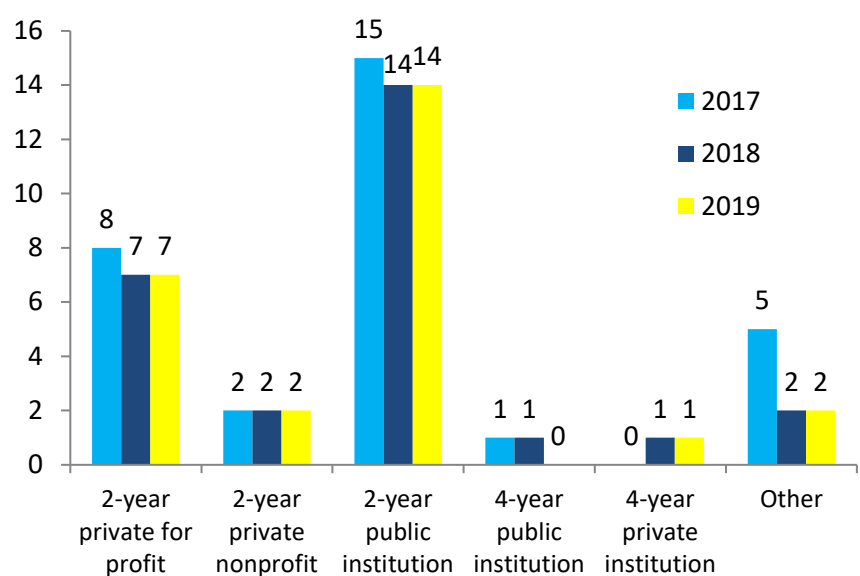


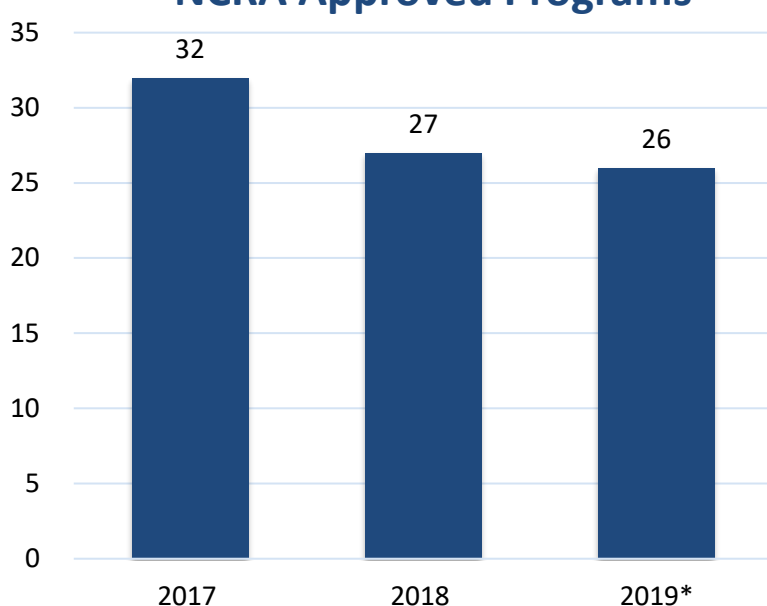

### Type of Institutions



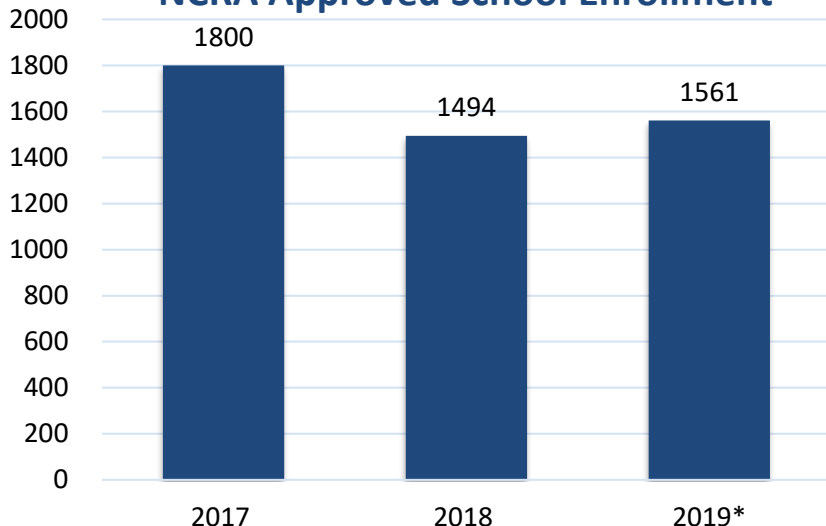

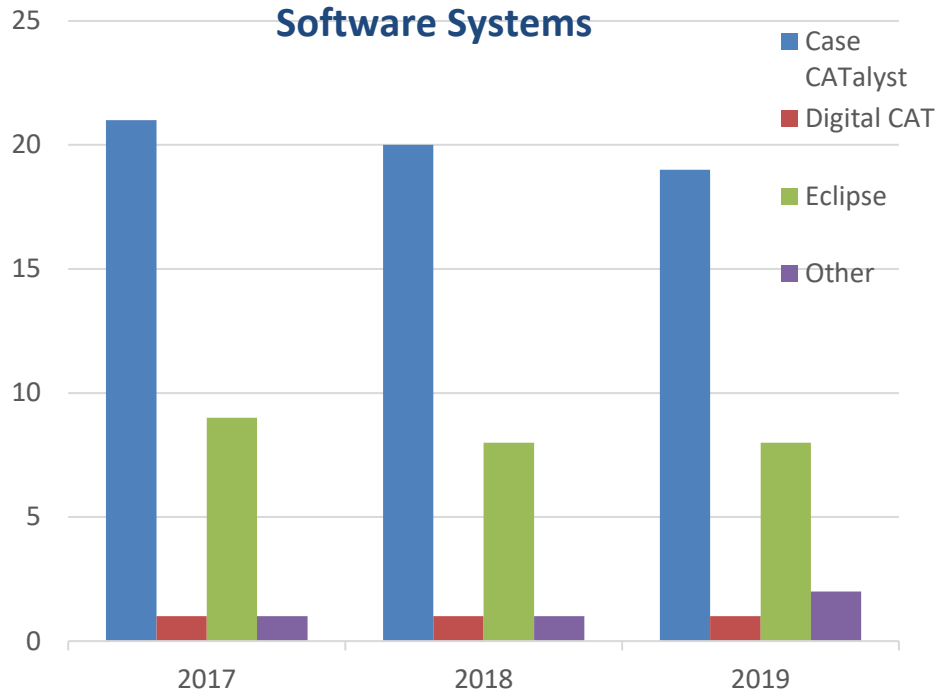
### NCRA Approved School Enrollment



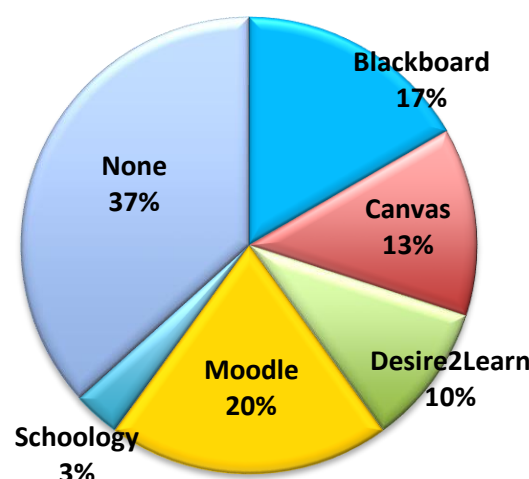

## ENROLLMENT OF NCRA A TO Z® PARTICIPANTS

The DiscoverSteno program continues to be a powerful recruitment tool. Since its inception, over 5000 leads from the DiscoverSteno Interest Inventory Survey have been sent to NCRA-approved schools. By the end of 2019, nearly 1300 participants had completed an NCRA A to Z Intro to Steno Machine Shorthand Program – either in person or online.

As of the beginning of 2020, NCRA-approved schools reported the following:

- 294 of their enrolled students had completed an A to Z program
- 71 of their students had participated in, but not completed, an A to Z program
- 11 of their graduates had completed an A to Z program

Many other A to Z completers have indicated they are enrolling in non NCRA-approved schools.
