- Speed verification form.
- A copy of the student's most recent academic transcript.
- Three recommendation forms. One recommendation must be from a faculty member or academic advisor.
 The recommendation form must be submitted; a letter in its place will not be accepted, and the application will be considered incomplete.
- A 500-600 word essay, double spaced, addressing the following prompt: How do you view artificial intelligence (AI) impacting the stenographic reporting profession? The student must also submit a third page listing a minimum of two different sources cited in researching the essay topic. The essay will be evaluated using the following criteria: content; organization; format; proper use of grammar, spelling, capitalization, and punctuation.
